### How many subjects do I choose?

- In addition to your core subjects (see table below), you have the opportunity to study subjects that you particularly enjoy but have also consolidated. These subjects may help you achieve your long-term goals. See the requirements below for specific on the number of units needed in Year 12.

### Requirements:

#### VCE

- To earn your VCE at Damascus College, we recommend students to complete 13 units in Year 11 (of which 1 unit of Religion and Society and 2 units of English are compulsory) and 10 units in Year 12 (of which 2 units are English). Please see further clarification on Religious Education at the bottom of the table (over the page).
- VTAC (Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre) advises that for the calculation of the ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admission Rank), students must satisfactorily complete **both** Unit 3 and Unit 4 of an English sequence.
- Three sequences of Unit 3 and 4 studies in addition to the sequence chosen from the English group. These sequences can be from VCE studies and/or VCE VET programs.

#### VCAL

- To earn your VCAL at Damascus students undertake studies in four curriculum strands: Literacy and Numeracy skills, Industry Specific Skills, Work Related Skills and Personal Development Skills. Students undertake structured workplace learning as part of the VCAL Work related Skills unit must complete VET as part of the certificate.
