For 2009, group lessons will be \$80 per term (\$10 per week), and private lessons will be \$200 per term (\$25 per week). Each group lesson is 40 minutes duration (where the maximum number of students in a group is three), while a private lesson is 30 minutes. An instrumental music term is eight weeks in duration, and shorter than a school term. This enables the possibility of catch-up lessons due to student/teacher illness or school events.

Vocal students are issued with a separate account from 'Coward Lemke Music', and are not invoiced through Damascus College.

\$50.00 DEPOSIT

A deposit is required to guarantee your child's enrolment in the instrumental program. This deposit is deducted from the first term of instrumental music fees.

USE OF DAMASCUS INSTRUMENTS

The College has a limited number of instruments available for students to use and hire. Where more students wish to use College instruments than are available, an arrangement can be made with 'Musicorp' for the hire and use of an instrument.

Guitarists and drummers are required to have their own instruments, but may use a College instrument on the day of their lesson if this is a more convenient arrangement.

PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITES

Each semester presents different performance opportunities. All students are expected to perform at the beginners music concert and at least one another performance.

TUITION DURATION

Tuition is for a minimum of one Semester. Where possible lessons are organised on a rotating timetable, so the same lesson is not missed each week. Lessons are also timetabled during the recess and lunch breaks and timetables are displayed in the student bulletin and on the music room window.

Students are required to maintain a page in their College Diary pertaining to their instrumental lesson times and absences from class.
