### 2019 YEAR 8 GENERAL BOOKLIST

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Please find below important information for the Year 8 booklist for 2019.

Purchasing second hand is a great way to save money on booklist items and a good place to start is via The 'Sustainable School Shop' which offer an online option for families which can be accessed by visiting [www.sustainableschools.com.au](http://www.sustainableschools.com.au)

Facebook is also a great way to source second hand school supplies. A popular group for local supplies is **Ballarat 2<sup>nd</sup> Hand School Supplies**. Please ensure you check the College's Uniform guideline and book requirements before you purchase anything privately to ensure you receive the correct items.

Students are to retain their Combination Locks until Year 12. If you require a new lock, these can be purchased from the College office at a replacement cost of \$14.

For the 2019 year, students will require additional resources as part of the Learning and Teaching program. This will include digital access to Oxford (including the Year 8 Oxford English Digital Resource and Cambridge Essential Mathematics 8 Digital Resource). As a result, all digital access will be included as part of the General Booklist and managed through Ballarat Books. The technology levy will now only cover the use of the student device, the Microsoft Surface Pro.

Students are required to have all the individual requirements for the below subjects. These are compulsory subjects that all Year 8 students undertake. The only choice is between French and Indonesian. As an example, if your child studied French in 2018, then he / she will study French in 2019 and you will need to purchase the texts and resources related to that language.

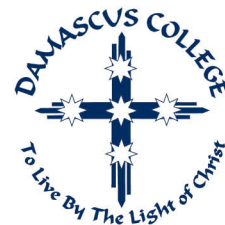

<p><b><u>FOUNDATION ENGLISH</u></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Foundation English – Students have been advised if they have been allocated Foundation English.</li> <li>• Students will be using a class set of novels so there are no novels to purchase for Foundation English.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>ENGLISH</u></b> Standard English</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>If you have ordered the English novels on the separate Early Start Program Booklist, please do not order on this list.</b></li> <li>• The ‘<b>Oxford Dictionary 8<sup>th</sup> Edition</b>’ MUST be purchased. This Dictionary will be used from Years 7-12.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>LANGUAGES</u></b> French  Indonesian</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ‘<b>Andomania 1 /1A English Version</b>’ – Only purchase the English version. Retain from Previous year. Only order if new to the school.</li> <li>• The ‘<b>Saya Bisa 1 Workbook</b>’. Retain from Year 7 and this workbook <u>must not</u> be purchased secondhand.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>ART</u></b> Art  Visual Communication Design</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Replenish used items from the previous year from the booklist so that your Art kit is complete.</li> <li>• You will use the same kit for Art, Visual Communication and ESTEEM subjects.</li> <li>• A separate Visual Diary will be required for Art, Visual Communication and ESTEEM.</li> <li>• A memory stick 16GB is required for all Year 7-10 Visual Communication. If possible use one from another subject or previous year.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>TECHNOLOGY</u></b> Metal and Wood  Food</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All students MUST purchase new safety glasses each year. Please use 1 pair for both subjects.</li> <li>• Please retain container from Year 7. No home brought containers will be accepted due to storage constraints.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>ESTEEM</u></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>ESTEEM</b> incorporates Science, Mathematics and Digital Technologies. There are no requirements for Science or Mathematics only the ESTEEM items are required.</li> <li>• <b>Do not purchase the ESTEEM requirements if you purchased them in the Early Start Booklist.</b></li> <li>• Students must bring the Visual Diary, 5 subject spiral bound notebook and Art Kit to this class.</li> <li>• Please retain the <b>Casio FX82AU Plus II</b> Calculator from Year 7.</li> </ul>



It is necessary for ALL students to have the requirements as listed in the General Booklist in order to start their classes.

Each year level has a different code, therefore it is important you have the correct code for the 2019 year.

- Visit [www.ballaratbooks.com.au](http://www.ballaratbooks.com.au) and Click on **Booklist Orders** on the left hand side, Enter the school code **DAMCUS08** and password **BKLIST** (THIS IS CASE SENSITIVE)
- Click **Display My List**
- Tick the items required and then '**Click to add checked items to your order**'
- Click **Confirm Order**
- Enter your students details
- '**Place Order**'
- Select your credit card and then **PAY NOW**

Once your order is filled you will receive a notification via post that it is ready for collection from Ballarat Books. **The Collection Centre is now located at 5 Yarroo St in Sebastopol.**
